

CONSIGNMENT POLICIES

We accept consignments of unwanted valuables in the categories of jewelry, coins and currency, collectibles of all kinds, small antiques and fine art. Each item must have a minimum estimated sale price of \$25. We may accept merchandise of lesser value that can be combined with other items from the same consignor in a single lot. We reserve the right to combine individual items into lots, and to accept or reject merchandise for consignment at our sole discretion.

We accept consignments at our San Antonio gallery on Monday through Saturday from 10am until 5pm. We may travel for larger consignments or for consignments of higher values.

While we seek to maximize value for our consignors, we also strive to make honest and accurate representations to our bidders. We reserve the right to make written and oral descriptions of consigned merchandise as we see fit.

Consignments are covered by our jeweler's block insurance from Jewelers Mutual and/or our business property insurance from The Hartford while it is in our care. We are licensed by the State of Texas, and we're members of the Better Business Bureau and the Greater San Antonio Chamber of Commerce. When you deal with us, you can deal with confidence!

Consignors may specify reserves on any or all of their merchandise. A reserve is the minimum net amount acceptable to the consignor for an item, not the amount that a consignor is hoping to realize. If a consignor specifies a reserve on an item, and if the high bid on that item fails to satisfy the reserve, we may agree to re-offer that item at a future auction at our sole discretion, and the consignor may agree to lower the reserve at his sole discretion. In any case, at such time that unsold merchandise is returned to a consignor, the consignor owes a fee of 3% of the last reserve amount, or \$15, whichever is greater.

Our commission rate is up to 30%:

- a) When you consider that we charge no buyer's premium for gallery bidders, a 30% commission rate is comparable to a 20% rate at a gallery that charges a 10% buyer's premium.
- b) Our commission rate is negotiable for consignments of particular value or prestige.
- c) Regardless of our commission rate, we will accept as little as a 10% commission rate, if necessary to consummate the sale. We consummate sales whenever possible!

We pay our consignors no later than 7 days after we receive good funds from our buyers.
